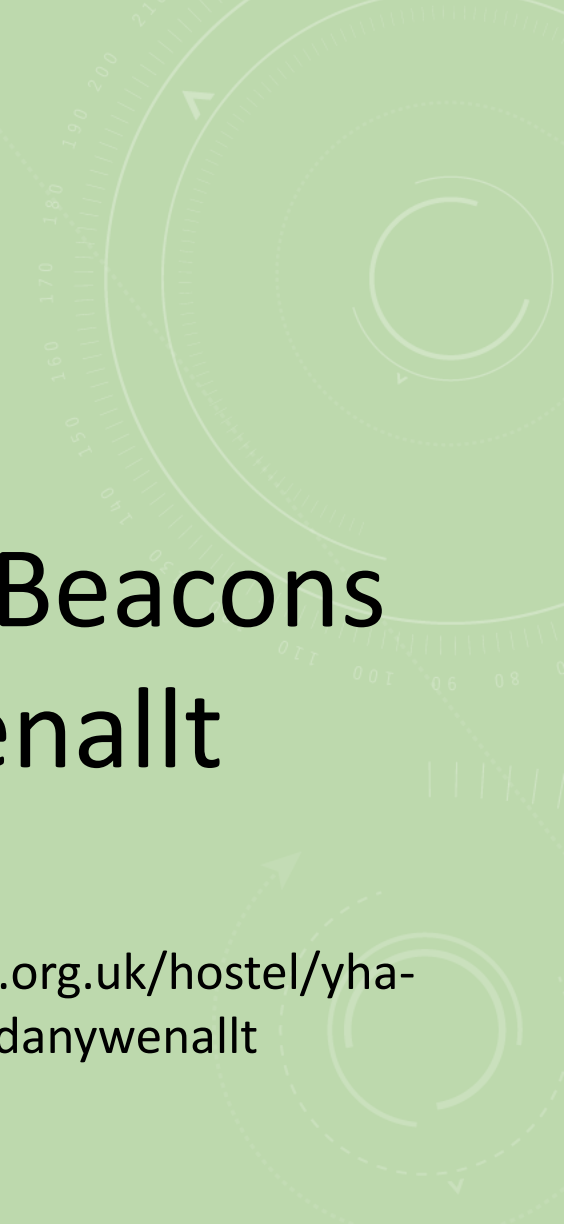

This is to be given to Mr Smith / Mrs Dharmasiri on the morning of departure

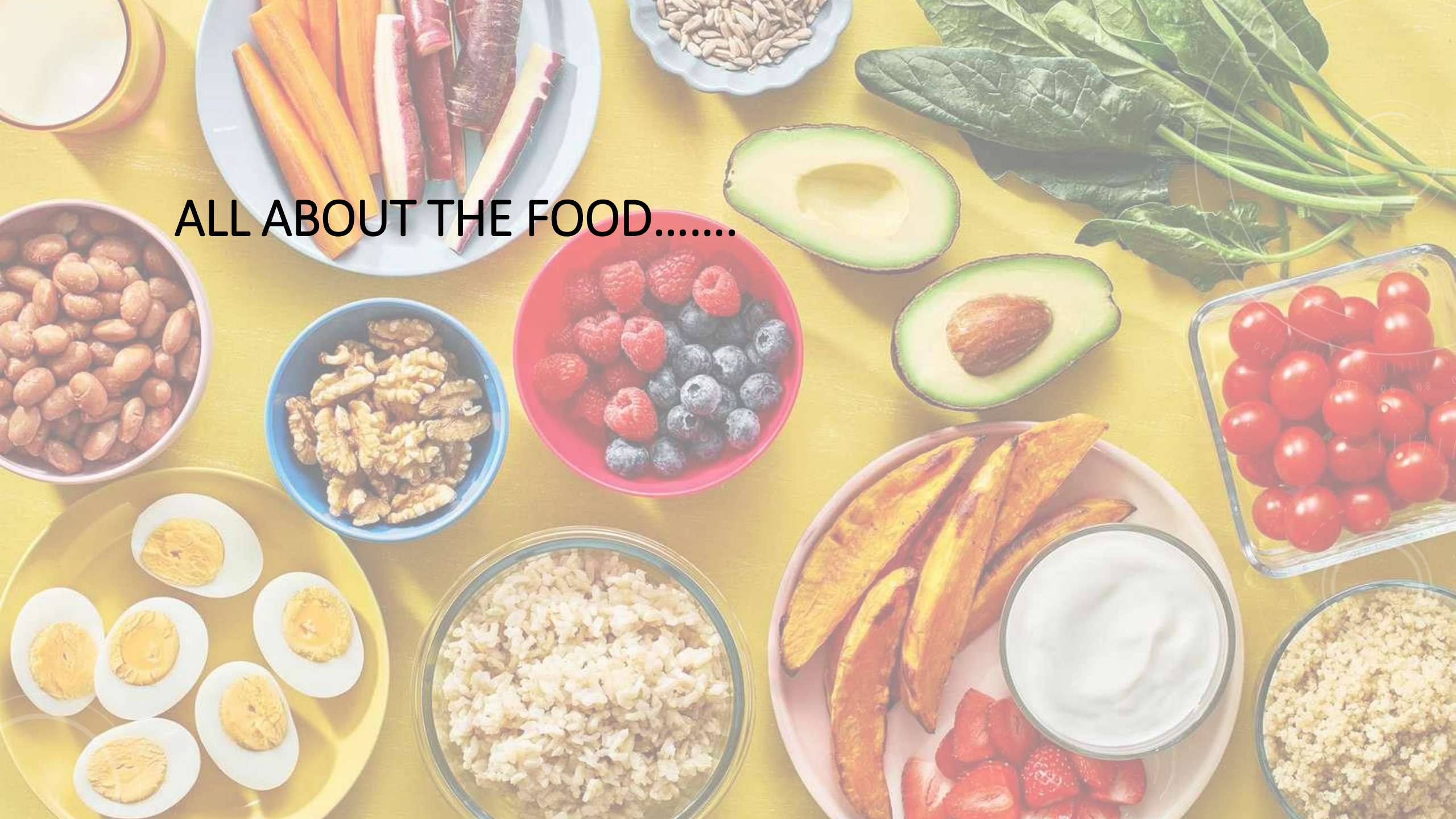
The children will be well fed with food produced on site. They will require a packed lunch on the day that we depart.

WHAT ABOUT GAMES AND ACTIVITIES?

WHAT HAPPENS IF I NEED TO CONTACT MY CHILD?

Telephone calls

Mobile phones are **NOT** to be brought on the trip.

We discourage parents phoning their children, and vice versa. In our experience it only makes it harder for the children in question to adjust to the new surroundings.

Teachers will have mobile phones with them and, in special cases, it is always possible to contact us via the centre's main office. We can give you contact details or Mrs Row can contact one of us.

We will also make contact with the school daily with news and information on how the trip is going, which will then be sent out via parentmail.

However the phone reception was poor when I conducted a pre-visit, likewise the wifi so as they say 'no news is good news'. But will try and update the school website each evening.

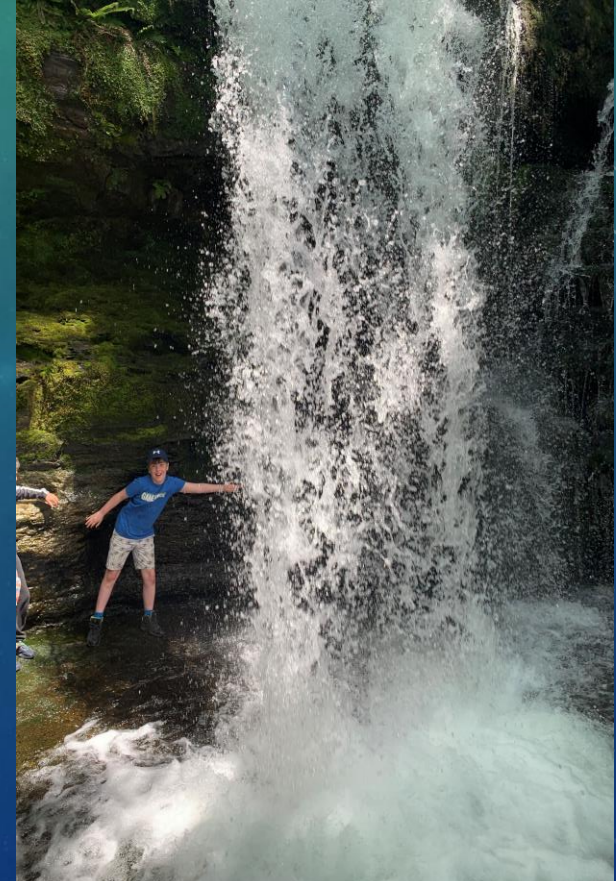

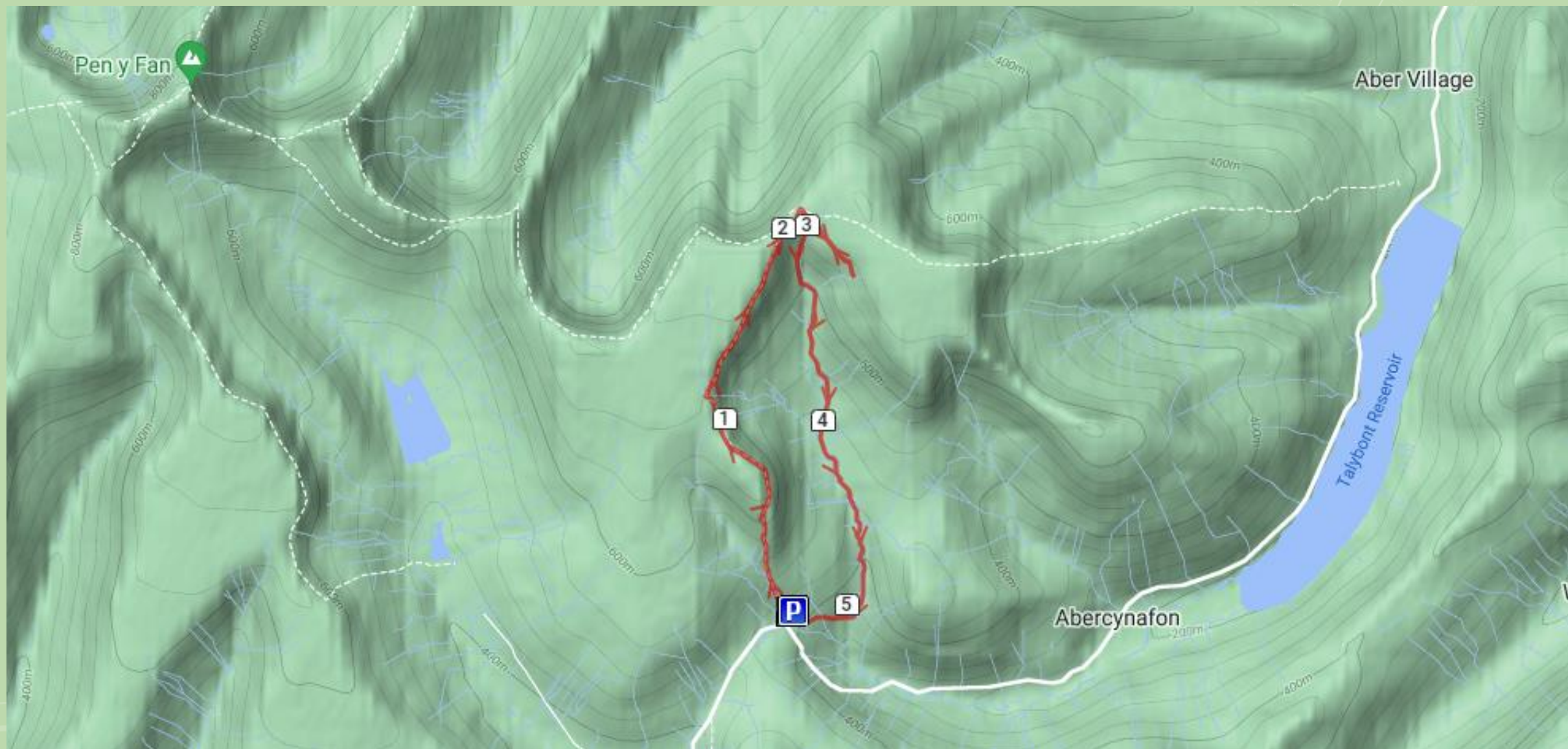

WHAT SHOULD WE PACK?

4 changes of old clothes (practical – think about the activities that they will be completing)

1 indoor set of clothes

2 sets of old trainers ideally and/or wellies.

Small rucksack/re-useable water bottle/evening drink plastic mug

Coat

Sun cream/Hat

Scarf/gloves/warm hat

Waterproof trousers/jacket

Torch

Camera – not expensive! Could be dropped!!

Washing bag – toothbrush, shower items, second towel

Three bin bags – to put dirty clothes into

Night clothes

For canoeing - Swimming costume/trunks/beach shoes/towel

All clothes MUST be labelled clearly with the child's name and a packing list included so the children can check the items back into their bags



WHAT FOOTWEAR DO WE NEED?

2 sets of old trainers ideally and/or wellies.

No crocs for activities, they slip off and are a safety hazard – although these could be used for the indoor shoes in the evening.
